

Mt. Mahogany Elementary School Community Council Agenda January 28, 2020

- **1. Welcome Mr**. Shirley welcomed the Council members, which included Niels Fugal from the DCC, and Mark Clement from the ASD School Board.
- 2. Celebrations Mr. Shirley showed the SCC our White Ribbon Safety Week video, and highlighted activities and dialogue that occurred with students throughout the week, which was a great success. It was discussed to send a modified version to the parents at some point in the future. Mrs. Schenk and Mrs. Glass also shared highlights of things happening with the grade level teams they are working with. Mr. Shirley mentioned how 5th Grade was able to bring numerous students from below grade level in DIBELS up to or above grade level. Mrs. Glass mentioned how grades K-3 are also making progress in DIBELS.
- **3. Stakeholder Report Review**—The Council reviewed our most recent Stakeholder Report, which was sent electronically to our school community a few weeks ago. The Council appreciated the elements contained in the Report, including the highlights of student activities and data supporting student growth.
- **4. Mid Year Budget Review** Mr. Shirley reviewed our remaining Trustlands budget with the Council members. All members were pleased to know we were on track to spend our budget completely or pretty close to it.

Total Budget: \$98,787 Expenditures: \$44,301, Remaining \$54,585.60

5.Discussion Items for 2020-21 — Items discussed with the Council included the following:

- Converting our current PTA book room to be a Sensory/ Wellness room using \$15,011 TSSA funding (this was proposed by Kate Larsen, seconded by Stephanie Glass, and was voted unanimously in favor by the SCC members
- We will be full Title I next year with an increased budget
- Our Christmas Sing in December was a huge success, with the gym almost at full capacity
- It was discussed to start a Ballroom Dance team—the Council discussed how it may be a good option if costs are feasible, but might be difficult given our demographic as a Title I school
- There was discussion on a STEAM/Robotics/Lego Club opportunity and the SCC members feel this may be an option if it does not offer any costs.
- **6. Upcoming School Plan** This item will be discussed further next month to solidify a plan to benefit our students.
- 7. Upcoming March Cookie Dough Fundraiser It was determined that a good option for our upcoming fundraiser in March to team with PTA for a 'playground' refresher, which would include some new equipment, new paint, and other items to enhance student experience on the playground.
- **8. School Safety Update** Mr. Shirley mentioned to the Council that our White Ribbon Safety week was a great success. In addition, our new cameras have been up and running recently and are fully functional now to give us access to our hallways, and exterior of all sides of the building.
- **9. Other Community Items for Discussion** There were no other items discussed.
